

FAAST Tournament Protocols

The following are our indoor guidelines for baseball and softball operations at the Cage.

Baseballs – we use a yellow ball inside the facility. Each team will be issued one ball for the event.

Rosters -- Head coaches must submit rosters, with names, addresses and phone numbers per Michigan rules plus WAIVERS (if you turned in this summer, you are good).

Arrival & Exit at the Venue: All spectators & team members must wear masks while entering and exiting the facilities. Spectators must wear them at ALL times. Players and coaches must wear them as well.

Attendance: Teams are allowed 2.5 supporters per player or 25-30 total attendees. Coaches and players don't count. Everyone who comes in has to sign in, answer 4 questions and temps will be taken. Mask has to be worn all times or will have to exit the building. Facilities will have designated entrance/exit areas & protocols. Its best social distancing is for spectators to bring their own toilet paper and hand sanitizer. Sites will have these items as well so see site directors for issues.

Concessions/food: Absolutely no food or drinks can be brought into the building. Drinks and snack can be bought. Players are allowed a cooler – do not bring full packs of water/Gatorade – only individual coolers.

Seating – Seating is only in Fieldhouse D (no longer in Field house A)

Attendees are encouraged to bring their own seats, Seating arrangements six feet apart will be marked off via paint/lines/markers. Young children will need to be supervised inside the social distancing guidelines.

Warm-ups -- Teams will be given a designated area to warm up 45 minutes prior to game time. Parents may enter 15 minutes prior to game time.

Dugouts –Teams are responsible for sanitizing allocated dugout space.
