

FAAST BASKETBALL EVENTS RETURN-TO-PLAY GUIDELINES

Athletes, Coaches, Spectators and Public

In an effort to help slow the spread of COVID-19, FAAST Basketball will be requiring facial coverings for all person(s) inside the facility during our events. We believe that by requiring facial coverings, we can better protect our athletes, coaches, officials, spectators, and staff. Masks will be available for anyone who does not have a mask accessible to them. Please see details below:

PLAYERS, COACHES, SCOREKEEPERS AND OFFICIALS

- Facial coverings **MUST** be worn while entering, exiting, and while not competing inside a facility

DURING PLAY

- - Players are **NOT** required to wear a facial covering or mask – **DURING PLAY ONLY**
- - Scorekeepers **MUST** wear a facial covering or mask

SPECTATORS

- Spectators **MUST** wear a facial covering while inside a facility during the tournament.
- Masks are available to anyone who does not have one.
- No admittance without a facial covering. **NO EXCEPTIONS!**

ATHLETES

- Only one backpack/bag per player is permitted inside the building
- No outside food inside the facility
- Athletes are encouraged to bring their own bottle with a screw top

Employees

Employees and event staff are required to wear masks

Daily temperature check and COVID-19 screening for all employees and event staff Employees are required to wash hands frequently throughout each day Employees will monitor sanitation stations around the facility

Employees and event staff will adhere to social distancing

Officials -- Daily COVID-19 screening for all officials

FACILITY

Each Facility will have directions for entering and exiting the building and admission instructions. FAAST will limit and regulate the flow of entry and fans are to enter for their child's game only, and parents/teams will be asked to leave immediately following their game to help keep the amount of people below set facility guidelines at any given time.

We will allow 2 to 2.5 parent/guardians per player to attend. Please have roster ready and waivers at this time. Each Team is allowed no more than 12 players, 3 coaches/scorekeeper on the roster.

Separate areas are designated for entering and exiting the building at all facilities

Seating is restricted to adhere to social distancing requirements

Concession stands and public drinking fountains remain closed

Ensure minimum of 6 feet between athletes, coaches, spectators and personnel where applicable

High-contact surfaces are disinfected after every change-over of teams and/or groups as well as restrooms and high traffic areas.

By entering the building or participating in the event, all parties acknowledge and are aware of the risk(s) to exposure to directly or indirectly arising out of, contributed to, by, or resulting from:

- An outbreak of any and all communicable disease, including but not limited to, the virus "severe acute respiratory syndrome coronavirus 2 (SARS-CoV-2)", which is responsible for Coronavirus Disease (COVID-19) and/or any mutation variation thereof;

Coaches Check-In and Spectator Admission Procedures:

- CHECK-IN WILL BE SET for each facility
- ONLY 1 Coach per team can enter facility for check-in. You must check-in at least 30 minutes before your scheduled game time.
- Rosters are limited to 12 players, 3 coaches/scorekeeper.
- Spectators are limited to 2.5 parent/guardian/fans per player.
- PLAYERS, COACHES, SCOREKEEPER, AND SPECTATORS WILL NOT BE ALLOWED INTO THE BUILDING UNTIL 10-15 MINUTES BEFORE EACH GAME.
- Everyone will enter through the main entrance and exit out of the back of the building. You will not be allowed to exit out of the main entrance
- PLAYERS, COACHES, AND SPECTATORS ARE REQUIRED TO WEAR MASKS WHEN INSIDE THE GYM (PLAYERS AND COACHES CAN REMOVE THEIR MASKS WHILE ON THE COURT)
- Players and team personnel should bring their own water bottle/drink.
- Each court will have a sanitation station.
- There will be no handshake or high-five lines at the conclusion of games
- Once your game IS finished, please exit the building as quickly as possible so the next round of teams can enter. Team meetings must be done outside of the facility!!!
